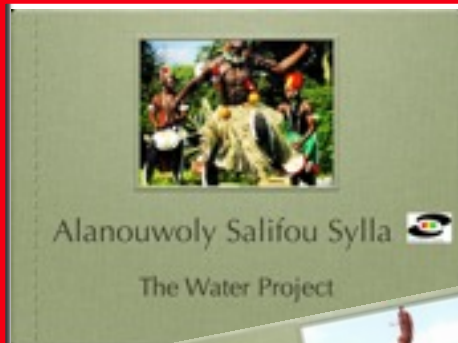


### School work

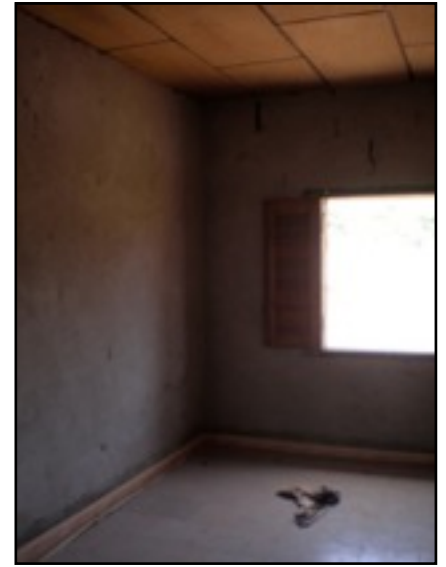

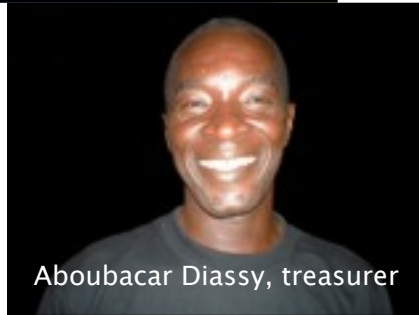

Alanouwaly Salifou Sylla in Guinea has adopted a constitution and is registered as a charity there since February 2013.

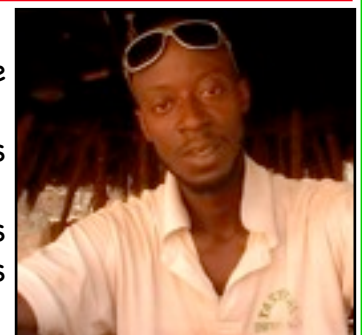
